Terms

Requirements

Students should be sure to have the following with them each day: (Please make sure that all belongings are clearly marked with the student's name)

Jeans

Shorts

Swim Suit & Towel (for sprinkler activities) or shorts and T-Shirt

A light, short sleeve shirt

A long sleeve sweater

A jacket (preferably water proof)

Footwear suitable for riding (something with a small heel is preferred) or runners.

Rubber boots if weather is inclement – we get really muddy here! These are not to be worn for riding.

Hat for shade

Riding Helmet (mandatory, a bike helmet or hockey helmet works well too)

Sunscreen

Refillable water bottle

Lunch, Snacks and beverages (Bottled water will be available at all times free of charge.)

The following items are NOT allowed on the premises:

Knives, matches, fireworks or weapons. Illegal substances will be confiscated and given to legal authorities. In order to preserve a "back to nature experience" and to promote socialization, we do not allow radios, CDs, tape players, or electronic games. Cell phones are permissible but ONLY for use during breaks and lunch.
